

How-To Install WTComm ActiveX Control

- 1) Click the **OCXNCI** icon from [here](#) to download the **WTCommV3.ZIP** file to any convenient folder or the desktop on your computer.
- 2) Unzip the file (typically by right-clicking on the file icon and selecting **Extract All...**)
- 3) Double-click on the **WTCommV3 Setup** folder to open the folder. You will see **the WTComm Setup.exe** file.
- 3) If installing to a 32-bit computer, you can now go directly to step 4.

However, if installing to a 64-bit computer, you must first set the 'Compatibility Mode' of the file. Right-click on the **WTComm Setup.exe** file and select **Properties**. Click on the **Compatibility** tab and Check the box that says "**Run this program in compatibility mode for:**", making sure the selection in the dropdown box indicates "**Windows XP (Service Pack 3)**". Click **Apply** and then the **OK** buttons to exit the properties settings.

- 4) Double-click on the **WTComm Setup.exe** file icon in the unzipped folder to start the installation.
- 5) When installation is complete, the control will be installed and registered on your computer. Since the control is used for design-time use, there is no shortcut placed on your desktop.
